From an Advent devotion by Doug Dicks, Presbyterian Mission's Associate for Ecumenical Partnerships, now serving in Jerusalem:

When I read Jesus' words in Luke 4:18-19, about the way of life that brings good news to the poor, release to captives, sight to the blind, and freedom to the oppressed, I see that the Universal Declaration of Human Rights upholds the same principles. When individuals, communities, and governments realize that we will not be pulled down by hatred and dehumanization, we will provide a light in the darkness and the star of Bethlehem will keep shining.

Also shared by Doug Dicks, from Bishop Sani Ibrahim Azar, Evangelical Lutheran Church in Jordan and the Holy Land, a partner church of the Presbyterian Mission:

We are overwhelmed with joy to see Jesus in the manger, for it was in Bethlehem that our hope was born! The joy of Christmas embraces us and brings us peace during the chaos and drama of life--even in the midst of occupation, and even when surrounded by rumors of war. This Christmas joy renews our faith and hope that soon and very soon, all the people of the Holy Land will know liberation, dignity, and peace based on justice. Kol sana wa enta salem!
