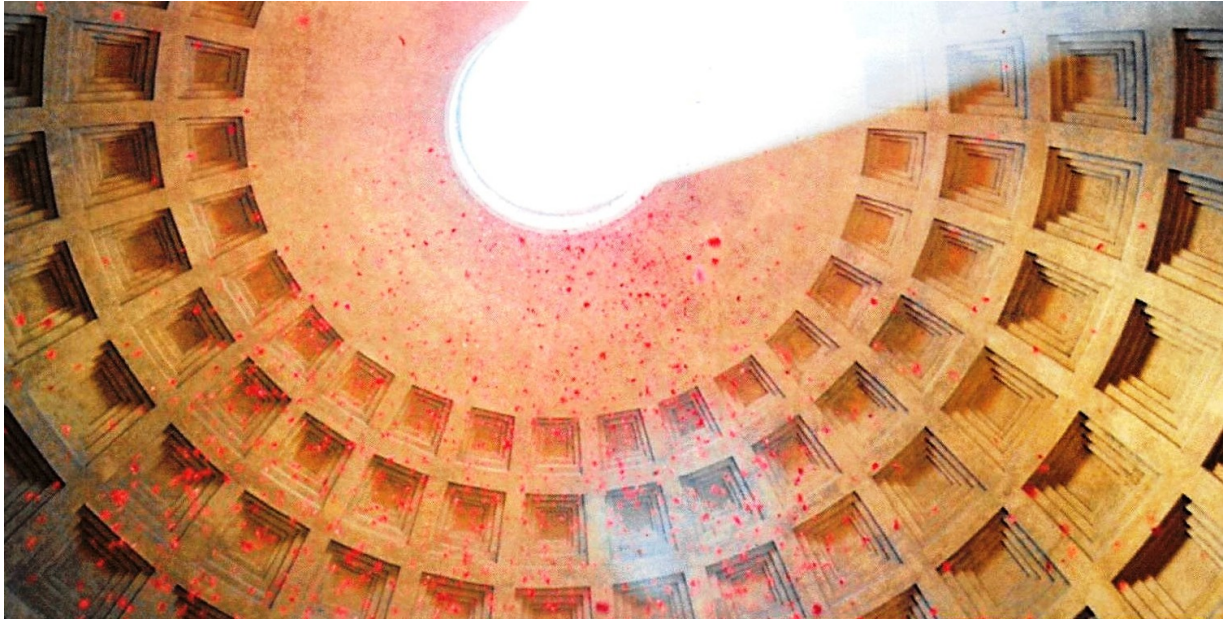

Prayer of Confession
